Former Peace Corps volunteers Tom and Elizabeth Arsenault will talk about their experiences in Swaziland and their plans to go to Zimbabwe to start a vocational school in a presentation tonight at International House, Davis.

The Arsenaults are involved in the African Self-Help Assistance Program, which teaches native residents skills to support themselves now in order to prevent the need for emergency relief in the future.
