## New This Season



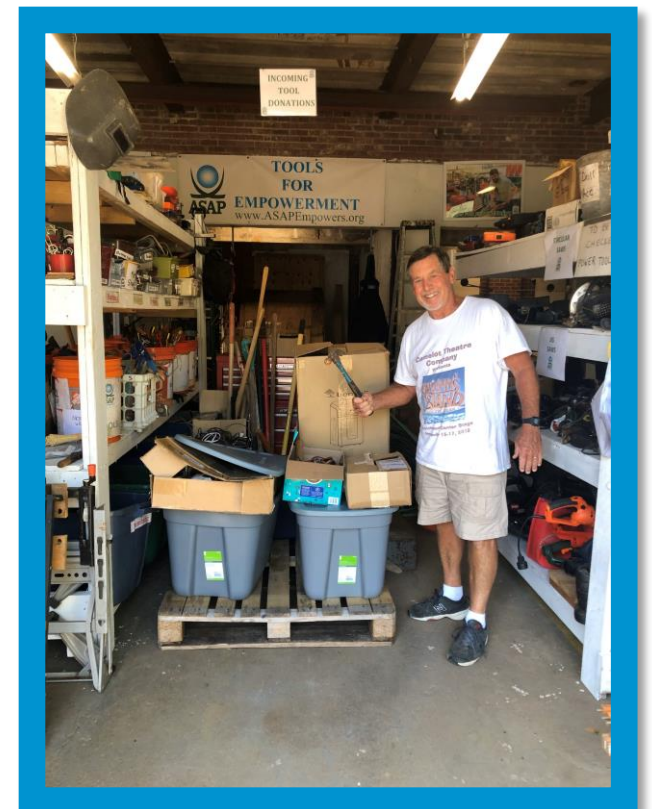
**Volunteers from The Heritage School!**
